- Teacher can easily access student work. GSS HiHo –Network Edition tags each file with the HotSync name of the student's device and groups hand-in by class.

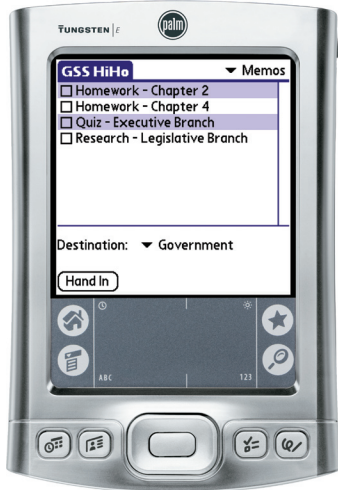

GSS HiHo–Network Edition uses HotSync Manager, included with your Palm OS handhelds and your schools existing file servers, to bridge the gap between student and teacher. If you have wireless-enabled devices, then you will want the wireless version of GSS HiHo, allowing you and your students to collect or hand out documents quickly and easily without hotsyncing!

GSS HiHo–Network Edition is easy to use, making it simple to integrate into the daily routine. To hand in documents, students simply tag their work on the handheld to be directed to a specific class. When they HotSync, documents are routed to the proper teacher. To make it easy to identify documents, each document is tagged with the HotSync name of the student's device. During the same synchronization, any files or documents handed out by teachers are transferred to the students handheld.

Teachers use GSS HiHo Desktop application to manage their classes. The GSS HiHo Desktop lets them distribute documents and files to entire classes, a subset of the class or individual students. In addition, it's used to collect work for review, grading and tracking progress. Since all data is stored in the GSS HiHo home directory, located on the school's file server, teachers can work from any computer in the school!

GSS HiHo simplifies the task of handing out Microsoft Office documents to students, enabling students to use Documents-to-Go to edit and create documents using their handhelds.

Students can even use the Palm Memo Pad application to write essays and hand them in. GSS HiHo–Network Edition brings simple and easy-to-use hand in and hand out capabilities to Palm OS handhelds, ensuring the most from your handheld investment.
